



Bloodborne and Infectious Diseases Policy

Students enrolled in an MTC Health Science Program should understand that the required clinical experiences on campus and in various health care facilities may expose them to environmental hazards and infectious diseases including, but not limited to Tuberculosis, Hepatitis B, and HIV. Neither MTC nor any of the clinical facilities used for clinical experience assumes liability if a student is injured or exposed to infectious disease in the clinical facility during assigned clinical experiences.

Students must understand that they are responsible for the cost of health care for any personal injury/illness that occurs during their education. MTC strongly recommends that students purchase their own health insurance. Students shall be required to wear the approved school uniform and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Students shall be required to observe CDC Guidelines for Infection Control and follow all applicable mandates of the OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard during all clinical activities.
