Optometric Assistants perform a wide variety of invaluable pre-testing and exam procedures. Assistants interpret prescriptions, help with frame and lens selection, and perform necessary measurements and adjustments for eyewear. Optometric Assistants have knowledge of anatomy, disease, injuries, and surgical procedures related to the eye. Students in MTI's program will gain at least 6 weeks of hands-on experience from interning at local Optometric and Ophthalmic offices. Graduates of MTI's Optometric Assistant Program are approved to sit for the national certification CPOA exam. The training is extensive, diverse, hands-on, and fun!
