Program Content:	The purpose of the Electrician program is to prepare students for employment or advanced training in a variety of electrical industries. The program covers use of tools, Ohms Law, blueprint reading, NEC (National Electric Code), DC and AC, circuits, basic safety, construction site etiquette, conduit bending, residential and light commercial “rough in/trim out” of wiring.
Length of Program:	1500 hours - approximately 15 months full time to complete
Class Hours:	Full-Time: 7:45 a.m. - 2:15 p.m., Monday - Friday
Admission Dates:	Fall Term: August, Deadline: June, or when classes fill Spring Term: January, Deadline: December or when classes fill Students are accepted on a first-come, first served basis.

Graduation Requirements:	Complete all of the programs competencies and projects. Score on the T.A.B.E exam: Reading 9.0, Math 9.0, Language 9.0
Industry Certifications:	NCCER Electrical – Level 1 NCCER Electrical – Level 2 NCCER Electrical – Level 3 NCCER Electrical – Level 4
College Credit:	Up to 6 credits towards AS degree in Engineering Technology at SCF.
Employment Potential:	Graduates of the program are employed in electrical trades. Starting salary ranges in Manatee County are approximately \$10.00 - \$12.00 per hour and with experience \$15.00 - \$20.00 per hour. Journeyman electricians can make \$20 or more per hour. Cooperative education is also offered to students who are 70% complete with their class work. This allows students to go to work while finishing their class requirements.
