1. Manatee Technical College signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that MTC has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
2. Manatee Technical College has received **\$2,644,460** from the Department of Education pursuant to MTC’s Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CARES Act, CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CARES Act, CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs as of the date of submission (*i.e.*, as of the initial report and every calendar quarter thereafter) is **\$2,302,539**.
